


Important Safety Instructions

- 1. Read and follow all instructions.
- 2. Save these instructions.
- Always be sure the unit is OFF and unplugged during installation or maintenance procedures.
- The Ultraviolet light produced by UV lamp is harmful to your eyes.
- Do not look directly at the lamp.



Each monitoring system with UV lamp is shipped with the germicidal lamp placed in a tube with protective packaging. Carefully remove lamp from the tube taking care to not touch the glass portion of the lamp with bare hands. If you accidentally touch a lamp, wipe it off using a soft cloth dampened with rubbing alcohol. The lamp is fragile and proper care must be taken when handling from packaging.



Wiring

The Electro Breeze UV/Filter Monitor is ready to work, no wiring is necessary, simply plug the monitoring sytem into a 120 volt outlet, plug the UV wire into the UV lamp and the Filter plug into the Filter electrical terminal. That is All.

Cautions

Do not touch the glass portion of the lamp with bare hands because oils from the hands can cause "HOT SPOTS" which reduce lamp life. Always wait 5 minutes after unpluging the lamp before servicing.

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Installation Instructions for Duct mounted style


1st step:

Install the UV Filter monitor System on the return duct of the HVAC system about 4 feet over the ground. Use the back cover of the monitor as a template to locate the 4 mounting screw holes.

2nd step:

To install the UV support plate, use the installation template included in the instruction kit, locate the 4 mounting screw holes and draw the UV clearance hole about 12 inches over the filter monitor system to be able to cut it out. Then drill the 4 holes and cut out the UV clearance hole in the duct.

3rd step:




Maintenance on UV lamp (Duct Mounted)

This maintenance schedule is only a guideline, determined by average conditions. Actual conditions will dictate the frequency of cleaning and/or replacement of lamps.

- Shut off the power switch on the left hand side of the monitoring system. Red LED will turn off (Fig. 1)
- 2. Unplug the lamp connector from the end of the lamp (Fig. 2)
- 3. Remove lamp holder using thumb nuts (Fig. 2)
- 4. Remove lamp by grasping the porcelain cap and extract carefully.
- 5. Using a soft cloth moistened with rubbing alcohol, wipe down the lamp. If there is a large build-up of dust particles, you may use a can of compressed air first. Always handle the ends caps (Fig. 3)
- 6. Slide the lamp back into lamp opening in the duct. Reinstall lamp holder (Fig. 2)
- 7. Plug the lamp connector to the end of the lamp (Fig. 3)
- 8. Turn the power switch back ON when maintenance is completed.

Clean lamp every 12 months. Replace the lamp every 24 months.







Warranty

Electro Breeze Air Cleaner Ltd warrants the Monitoring system against defects in materials and workmanship for a period of 5 years from the date of installation. The UV lamp carries a two year warranty. This warranty does not cover broken lamps due to installation or bad handling.
